National Challenges

- Over 900 CEO transitions in last 6 years
- 75% of presidents plan to retire in next 10 years
- 75% of senior administrators plan to retire in next 10 years
- 146 new presidents hired in one year: May 2012—April 2013

California Challenges

- 137 chancellor/president positions
- 22 open or interim positions in February 2016
- 17 new chancellors/presidents as of January 2015
- Unions, Salaries, Tenure
